PRODUCT TYPE OR USE: Alcohol mixture for antiseptic treatment of hands.

Section 2. EMERGENCY OVERVIEW

Appearance: A clear, colorless liquid with a mild alcohol odor.

Flammable: Store and use away from high heat, sparks, fame and all other ignition source

Health Effects: Ingestion: May be harmful or fatal if swallowed. Keep Out Of Reach Of Children May cause upset of stomach, vomiting, nausea, diarrhea, or Central Nervous System depression.

Inhalation: Avoid breathing of vapors or breathing mist to contact mucous membranes where prolonged contact causes irritation. Prolonged exposure to fumes may cause headache, drowsiness and inability to concentrate.

Eyes: Causes eye irritation, burning or redness of eyes on contact.

Skin: May cause redness or irritation of skin upon prolonged contact. No adverse affects are expected when used as a skin antiseptic.

Section 4. FIRST AID MEASURES

Eye Contact: Immediately flush eyes with water for 15 minutes while removing contact lenses. Get medical attention.

Skin Contact: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash with water. If irritation develops, get medical attention.

Ingestion: Harmful if swallowed. Do not induce vomiting. Give water to dilute. Contact a Poison Center or physician.

Inhalation: Move to fresh air. If breathing difficulty continues, get medical attention.

Extinguishing Media: Dry chemical, Carbon Dioxide, or Foam. Water may be ineffective, but water should be used to cool fire exposure containers. If a leak or spill has ignited, use water spray to disperse the vapors and to protect persons attempting to stop the leak. Water may be used to flush and dilute spills to a non-flammable mixture.

Special Fire Fighting Procedures: Standard fire fighting procedures may be followed, including wear of full protective gear and NIOSH self-contained breathing apparatus in fire area.

Unusual Fire and Explosive Hazards: Use ventilation to prevent explosive levels of alcohol vapor to develop in air if spilled.

Products of Combustion in Fire: Forms oxides of carbon.

Section 6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Contain spill. If a large amount of product is spilled, wear NOISH approved respirator. Mop up and clean surface with water. Discharge small amounts of diluted chemicals to a sanitary sewer. Caution, spilled product will cause slippery surface. Avoid falls, clean up spills immediately. Spills of this product usually do not need to be reported to the National Response Center because of the small quantity in normal service packages.

Section 7. STORAGE AND HANDLING

Store in original package at room temperature. Keep Out Of Reach Of Children.

Other Precautions: Use only in accordance with label directions.

Do not smoke or use near sparks or open flames.

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Eye Protection: None usually needed when product is used from a dispenser as a skin antiseptic. If situations for eye contact with product occur, wear safety glasses or chemical goggles.

Skin Protection: None needed under normal use conditions.

Respiratory Protection: None required under normal use conditions.

Ventilation: None required under normal use conditions. Local exhaust when fumes are detected.

Clothing or Other Protective Equipment: No special protection required under normal use conditions.

Work Hygiene Practice: Never eat or smoke when handling chemicals. Wash thoroughly after handling.

Carcinogenicity: Ingredients are not listed by NTP, OSHA, or IARC.

Section 12. ECOLOGICAL CONSIDERATIONS

No ecological or special considerations are expected when used according to directions. Not considered environmentally harmful from normal dilution, expected usage, and typical drainage to sewers, septic systems and treatment plants.
